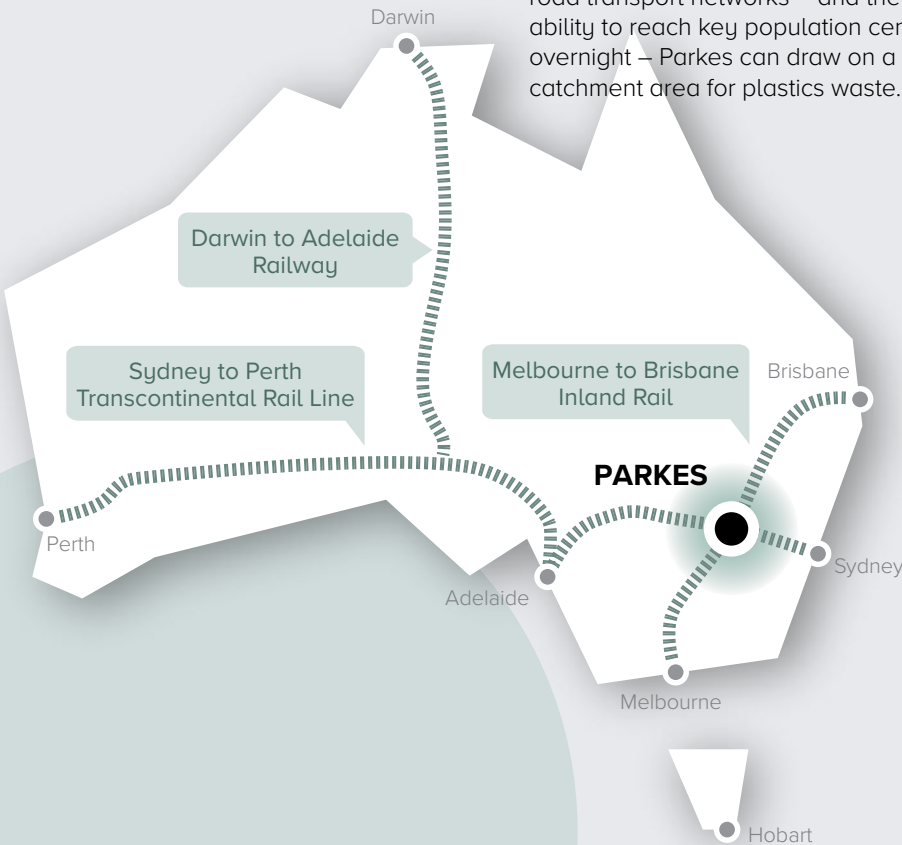

Why Parkes for plastic recycling?

Centrally located

Parkes is centrally located to Australia's major cities and sources of plastic waste. With extensive rail and road transport networks – and the ability to reach key population centres overnight – Parkes can draw on a large catchment area for plastics waste.



Land cost and availability

Industrial land in the Parkes Special Activation Precinct costs just 3 – 5% of that within major metro areas. There are more than 700 hectares available within the specialised recycling precinct.



Cost-effective utilities

The Parkes precinct has a well-planned and sustainable utility system including two power substations with 100MVA spare capacity. In addition, there is:

- a dedicated natural gas network
- existing 3G and 4G services, with 5G to be rolled out under the NSW Government's Gigstate program
- a well-planned network of potable and recycled water to support businesses.
