Why Wagga Wagga for plastics to fuel?



Efficient, renewable utilities

The Wagga Wagga precinct will be supported by efficient, renewable energy, gas and water supply networks, each with spare capacity to support growth. The precinct will offer onsite access to green hydrogen and aims to achieve 100% renewable energy through solar and biomass generation.



Established refining sector

Wagga Wagga is already home to a refinery employing skilled workers, and an innovation ecosystem ready to support collaboration on waste recovery and reuse. The University of Sydney and NSW Circular Economy Innovation Network offer opportunities for research and alliances for operators redirecting waste from landfill for recycling, reuse and refining.



Market access and connections

Wagga Wagga is NSW's southern gateway and offers easy access to domestic and export markets. Operators will have access to international ports and 75% of Australia's population overnight. Positioned on the Inland Rail, the precinct will house the Riverina Intermodal Freight & Logistics Hub and an inland port.



Access to feedstock

The precinct will leverage Wagga Wagga's location central to the Sydney and Melbourne to connect investors with feedstock and customers. NSW and Victoria create more than 2.6 million tonnes of plastic waste each year alone. The Inland Rail will also connect the precinct with Queensland's main population centres and waste catchments.
